FLEOA Foundation Continues Efforts to Raise Money for Slain Park Ranger; Welcomes Congressman Reichert as Honorary Chairman

Today, the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association (FLEOA) Foundation is proud to announce that Congressman Dave Reichert (R-WA) will serve as the Honorary Chairman of the FLEOA Foundation fund set up in honor of slain Park Ranger Margaret Anderson.

“Congressman Reichert has been a strong supporter of the law enforcement community and his support will help ensure that the FLEOA Foundation can continue to provide assistance to Park Ranger Anderson’s family as they deal with this difficult time,” noted FLEOA President Jon Adler.

On January 1st, National Park Ranger Margaret Anderson was tragically killed in the line of duty. While establishing a road block to prevent a pursued suspect from escaping, Margaret was fatally wounded by the suspect - a deranged gunman - who opened fire on her. After firing at Margaret and other responding law enforcement officers, this deranged homicidal maniac fled into the surrounding area. A manhunt was convened in pursuit of this heinous coward, and he was ultimately found dead. Margaret is survived by her husband Eric, who is also a Park Ranger. They have two young daughters.

“Park Ranger Anderson is a true hero who dedicated her life to law enforcement and protecting others. I am honored to help create a lasting legacy for her family and to support the efforts of the FLEOA Foundation,” stated Congressman Reichert.
